**Palestine Red Crescent Society: Response Report**

**As of Saturday, October 7<sup>th</sup> 2023, 6:00 PM**

**Until Wednesday, November 15<sup>th</sup> 2023, 24:00 AM**

Palestine Red Crescent Society teams are still responding to the developments on the ground in both Gaza Strip and the West Bank, where the operations are carried out 24/7, For the 39th day in a row.

The following information in this report is the maximum which our teams were able to collect from direct follow-ups and different sources due to the complete loss of telecommunications and the great difficulty in reaching the sources of information.

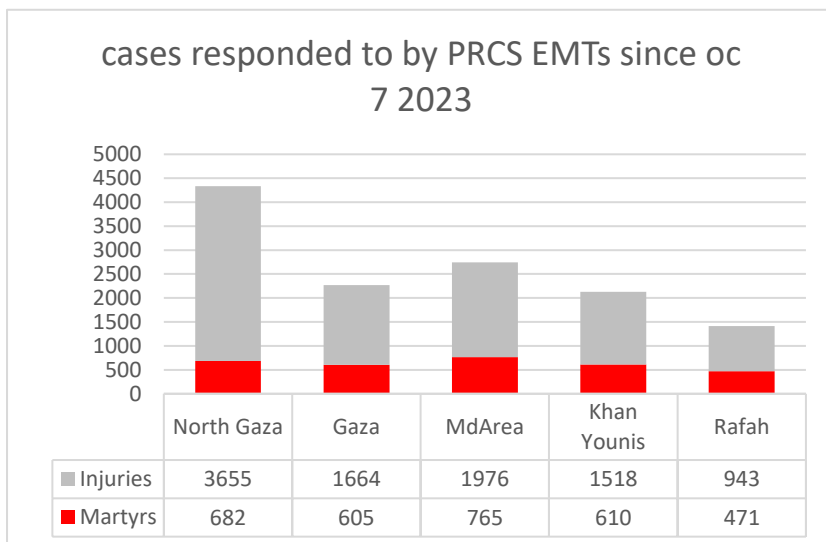
**Latest Updates:**

**Gaza Strip:**

- On November 14<sup>th</sup>, 2023, our crews managed to evacuate the sick, wounded, and their families from Al-Quds Hospital to Khan Younis in light of the ongoing Israeli bombardment of the hospital zone and siege of the persons in it. A complete power outage, the depletion of food and water for patients, and the Israeli Occupation's denial of the hospital's access to medical and humanitarian supplies has rendered the continuation of medical care at Al-Quds Hospital impossible.
- Despite the power outage at PRCS's Al-Amal Hospital, our crews continue to provide medical services there, even if resorting to traditional medicine is necessitated.
- The PRCS's emergency line "101" has received hundreds of calls from besieged citizens requesting ambulance crews to transport martyrs and casualties and to aid the evacuation of families that have been stuck in their homes with no supply of food or water due to the ongoing Israeli bombardment. Meanwhile, the Society's crews are unable to reach those affected due to the Occupation's targeting of ambulances that are trying to approach the locations of Israeli military vehicles.

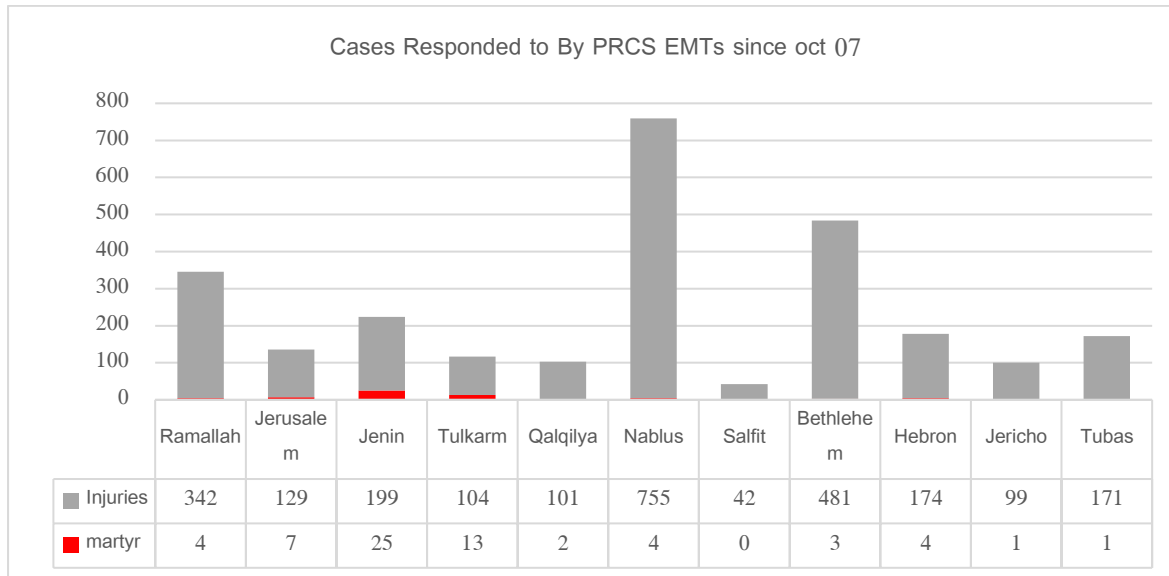
• **PRCS Emergency medical services response**

**Gaza Strip:** PRCS EMTs responded to (9756) casualties, and (3133) martyrs since the beginning of the escalation. The chart below indicates to the figures. As the Ministry of Health announced that (11180) martyrs and (28200) injuries "4609 children - 3100 women - 678 elderly, these statistics remain preliminary due to the many of missing people under the rubble." From 07.10.2023 to 12.11.2023 at 15:00.

**West Bank and Jerusalem:** PRCS EMTs responded to (2) injuries during the Israeli Occupation's raid of Beit Kahel town in Hebron and Jenin, as of today November 15<sup>th</sup> 2023 until 24:00 AM. Thus, the total number of casualties responded to by PRCS teams from Oct 7<sup>th</sup> 2023 until November 15<sup>th</sup> 2023 is (2598) casualties and (64) martyrs. And the Ministry of Health reported (183) martyrs and more than 2500 casualties since 7<sup>th</sup> October, 2023 until 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2023.
