Palestine Red Crescent Society: Response Report**As of Saturday, October 7th 2023, 6:00 PM****Until Saturday, December 2nd 2023, 00:00 AM**

Palestine Red Crescent Society teams are still responding to the developments on the ground in both Gaza Strip and the West Bank, where the operations are carried out 24/7, for the 58th day in a row.

The following information in this report is the maximum which our crews were able to collect from direct follow-ups and different sources due to the complete loss of telecommunications and the great difficulty in reaching the sources of information.

Latest Updates:**Gaza Strip:**

- This evening, the occupation forces penetrated the area separating the Central Governorate and Khan Yunis Governorate, and worked to separate the two governorates from each other, targeting any movement in the vicinity of the place.
- The Occupation's operations in targeting residential buildings and their residents have significantly increased, as they targeted more than 9 residential blocks during the day and leveled them to the ground, leading to a large number of victims who are still under the rubble to this moment.
- The separation of the two governorates due to the Occupation's incursion is increasing challenges facing the working medical and relief teams as it prevents the movement of ambulance vehicles from approaching the places of incursions and targets everyone who tries to move there. The Occupation is also forcing citizens to move at certain times through Salah al-Din Street, and targeting some of them with death, injury, arrest, humiliation or inhuman treatment.
- All hospitals in Gaza are out of service including Al-Shifa and Al-Quds Hospitals due to the Israeli Occupation's siege and ban on medical services. The crews and patients have also been forced into displacement towards the south, increasing the size of the disaster in north of Wadi Gaza, precluding hundreds of victims due to the halt of first aid and medical services to the wounded.
- The Occupation forces continue to besiege and to directly target the Indonesian Hospital while impeding the work of medical crews as they are prevented from reaching the hospital.
- A The competent authorities continue to recover the bodies of the martyrs from the streets and under the rubble; the recovery crews are facing high challenges in performing their missions because there is no fuel available for the necessary machines which have already been exhausted. Official authorities have received approximately (7000) reports of missing persons in the rubble and corpses laying in the streets including well over (4700) children and women.
- The fuel crisis in PRCS' Al-Amal Hospital in Khan Younis persists as consumption is reduced to the minimum level, affecting the services provided to the wounded and the sick, including first aid and emergency medical services.
- PRCS colleague **Awni Khattab** Head of Khan Younis Ambulance Center remains detained by the Israeli Occupation forces for the 11th day in a row. He was arrested during the wounded convoy from Al-Shifa Hospital, traveling through the checkpoint which separates north and south Gaza.
- The Ministry of Health confirms that the occupation forces deliberately target medical personnel and crews, which led to the loss of (280) medical personal lives, (26) from the rescue team members and the wreckage of (56) ambulances that are now un-operable. The Ministry of Health also confirms that (20) hospitals and (46) health centers are out of service as a result of Israeli targeting and the depletion of fuel and medical resources.
- The number of governmental headquarters which the Israeli Occupation has destroyed has reached (103), in addition to (267) schools, (67) of which have gone out of service.
- The number of completely destroyed mosques has reached (93), partially destroyed mosques (181), in addition to (3) targeted churches.
- Based on official data, (76) journalists have been directly targeted and martyred since the beginning of the aggression on Gaza

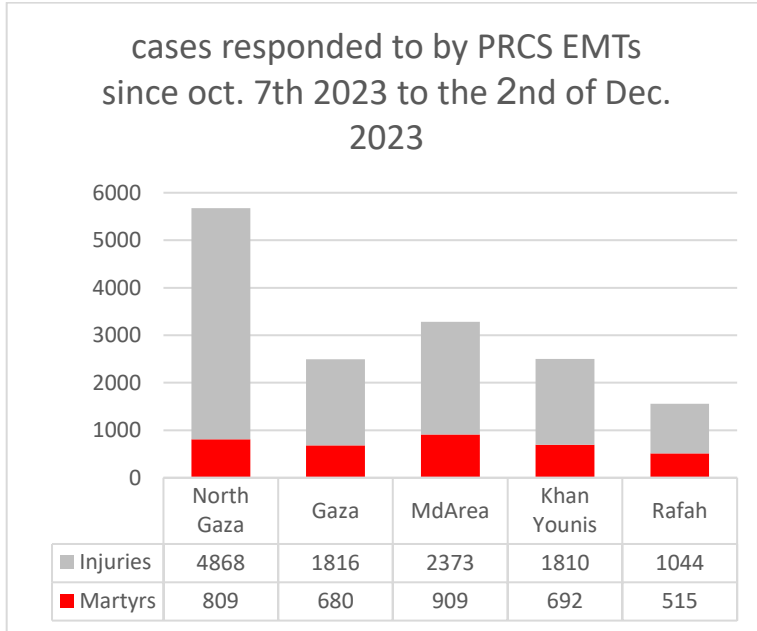
West Bank:

- Nablus Governorate: the PRCS medical teams dealt with (37) casualties including (10) live ammunition casualties which were transported to the hospital and (25) choking cases which were dealt with in the field in addition to (2) choking cases which were transported to the hospital during the Israeli Occupation's raid of Beita and Awarta areas.
- Jenin Governorate: PRCS teams transported (2) casualties: (1) live ammunition casualty during the Israeli Occupation's raid of Jaba' and (1) bullet fragment casualty during the Occupation's raid of Yamoon.
- Salfit Governorate: PRCS teams transported (1) martyr and (2) live ammunition casualties during the Israeli Occupation's raid of Bani Hasan villages.



• **PRCS Emergency medical services response**

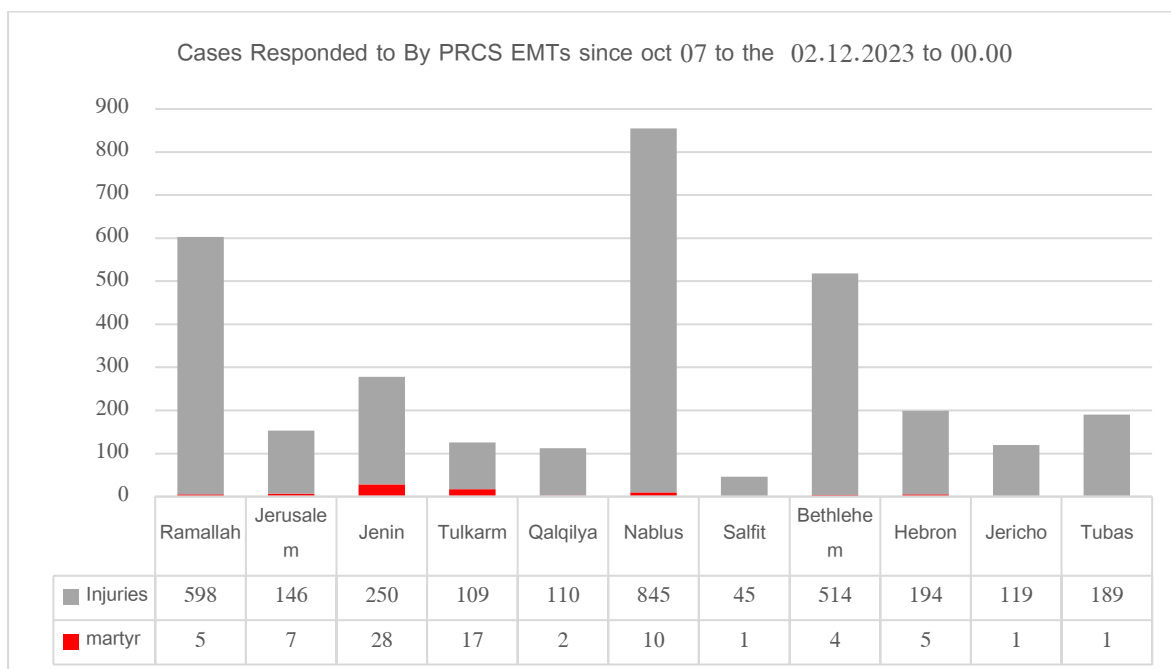
Gaza Strip: PRCS EMTs responded to (11911) casualties, and (3605) martyrs since the beginning of the escalation, according to the last report from the Central Operations Room of Gaza on December 2nd, 2023 at 00:00. The chart below indicates to the figures. As the Ministry of Health announced that (+15,207) martyrs and (+40,650) injuries "6150+ children – 4000+ women and 700+ elderly, these statistics remain preliminary due to the many of missing people under the rubble."

Ambulance centers continue to operate at high capacity in light of the events taking place. Today's operational capacity was (17) ambulance vehicles operating in the field, (2) of which were special use vehicles. The number of staff working within this capacity is (65) including ambulance crews, drivers, emergency response, administration, and volunteers.

West Bank and Jerusalem: PRCS EMTs responded to (1) martyr and (46) casualties as of today, December 2nd, 2023 until 00:00. Thus, the total number of casualties responded to by PRCS teams from Oct 7th 2023 until November 29th 2023 is (3119) casualties and (81) martyrs. And the Ministry of Health reported (239) martyrs and more than (3000+) casualties since 7th October, 2023 until 28th November, 2023.



Violations against PRCS teams:

The Palestine Red Crescent Society enjoys special protections yielded by international humanitarian law, particularly the Geneva Conventions, and operates within the framework of its humanitarian responsibilities governed by said legal documents. The following recorded violations against our crews, vehicles, and patients are documented in accordance with the First and Fourth Geneva Conventions, the Additional Protocol (I) to the Geneva Conventions, and customary international law.

Disaster Risk Management Response:

The Gaza Strip:

- The PRCS' relief teams continue their various efforts in responding to the displaced in all areas of the Gaza Strip, which are suffering from a major disaster due to the aggression on Gaza, in addition to the displacement centers in coordination with the relevant institutions.
- The total number of trucks received by PRCS from 10/21/2023 until the date of this report was (2628) trucks, including 1091 trucks during the humanitarian truce period that lasted 7 days.
- number of trucks that entered the northern Gaza areas during the humanitarian truce period (310) trucks containing food, relief materials, drinking water, milk, and tents.
- number of trucks distributed by the association through its working crews is 1,913 trucks as of 11/30/2023.
- number of ambulances received by PRCS is 30, and they were distributed according to an approved mechanism in coordination with the relevant authorities.
