

VIOLATIONS AGAINST PRCS MEDICAL MISSIONS 2023 SEMIANNUAL REPORT

Israeli Occupation Authorities continue to disrupt the conduct of medical missions in the Occupied Palestinian Territory. This policy has been translated into direct attacks against medical personnel, vehicles, and units.


As a voluntary relief organization providing various medical and health services, Palestine Red Crescent Society (PRCS) has also been subjected to Israeli occupation violations.

During the first half of 2023, PRCS recorded 193 violations against its medical missions*, consisting of denial or delay of access to the sick and wounded, and harassment and attacks against medical teams and vehicles.

Such actions violate the principles and provisions of International Humanitarian Law (IHL) related to the protection of medical missions, particularly the Fourth Geneva Convention of 1949.
